Description:

The Gaston County Museum of Art and History is currently seeking one curatorial intern for the spring of 2020. This position will focus on exhibit development, research and installation. This position will equip candidates with experience using PastPerfect Museum Software, accessioning, processing and preserving archives, basic construction skills, exhibit design and installation, and an immersive work experience.

Interns will work directly alongside the Museum Curator.

The successful candidate will be detail oriented, organized, and able to work independently and with a team. Willingness and proficiency with data entry is essential. A strong sense of self-motivation is key.

The intern must be able to work with and meet deadlines, lift up to 30 pounds, and climb stairs and ladders. Preference will be given to candidates wishing to pursue a career in museums or archives.
